

SNEH is an acronym for Solid Nutrition, Education and Health. Our vision is to have no child in our beloved country being deprived of the elementary necessities of life and his/her rights.

Snapshot – COMAL

- 700+ severely malnourished children have been identified till date from 15 slum pockets of PCMC. In 2016, 200 kids from 3 slum pockets were the target beneficiaries.
- 90% children have moved to healthy zone and have sustained in the last 3 years.
- 5000+ families indirectly impacted by conducting street plays, digital sessions, recipe sessions etc. in the communities.
- Various awareness activities are taken during each of the project cycles so that the nutritional and health status of the children remain sustainable. Below are some of these activities.



Snapshot - COMAL- Kothrud

- Project is being initiated in liaison with Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) popularly known as “Anganwadis”.
- 300 severely and moderately underweight children have been identified from 30 Anganwadis and the awareness based intervention is in progress.
- Multi-dimensional theme based approach is being implemented covering “frequency of food”, “food pyramid”, “baal-kopara (Food corner for kids)”, “recommended dietary allowance” etc. to ensure sustainable development.

COMAL

- 96% of 200 kids from the COMAL project were not only shifted from the malnourishment zone to a healthy zone, but were also given vaccinations, regular health check-ups, necessary medicines/tonics and dietary follow ups.
- With the help of street plays, training of ICDS staff and reaching out to local self-help groups (SHG's) we were able to reach to 2500+ community members. 2500 community members impacted directly, and more than 1000 families were exposed to the program by taking ICDS team in loop.
- Out of the 200 families from the COMAL project, 75% of them were positively impacted through the Family Development Project that focused majorly on health & socio-economic issues. Health objectives were further divided into hygiene, immunization and gynae health issues. Similarly, socio-economic objectives were additionally categorized into parenting & child care, deaddiction, income improvement, savings and family planning.

IMPACT through COMAL

COMAL- Kothrud

- 300 kids were shifted to a healthy zone from the malnourished zone
- 1000+ population was impacted through street plays, awareness sessions etc. at the community level
- 3 Severe health cases were dealt with during the project course

Siddhant

Constant intervention leads to positive results

Siddhant was a part of our combat malnutrition project with Tata Motors. Siddhant belongs to poorest of the poor family and at the time of project enrollment, his parents were not able to provide even a 2-course meal to the kids. The family had every possible social problem on the radar with an abusive father and anemic mother. Siddhant was suffering from chronic malnutrition and used to survive on leftover food. After the therapeutic and medical intervention, Siddhant showed tremendous weight gain and moved to healthy zone.

SNEH team worked hard to counsel Siddhant's parents. While it was comparatively easy to give direction to the mother, it took our team a lot of time to get the father onboard. After continuous efforts mother and father have now become aware and concerned about the health of their kids. Father is now working hard to provide for his family. This case is an example that constant intervention leads to positive results.



Disha - It is about overall development from kid to family

Disha was suffering from chronic malnourishment when we enrolled her to our Tata Motors' COMAL project. Her immunity was very low and hence she used to fall sick every now and then. Our team worked hard to counsel the family and initiate a nutritional intervention. In a matter of few months Disha showed incredible improvement. Her weight and height increased, and frequency of sickness reduced.

What makes this story special is that her mother Rohini's thought process changed drastically and she became aware about health and nutrition aspects of her kids. Also, after attending every awareness session and following the protocol religiously, she felt more self-confident. She spoke about how SNEH foundation has changed her life in a recent program at Tata Motors and received applause. These stories inspire us to go out there and work even harder to bring sustainable social change.

Education



Snapshot – Project Gyan

- Project Gyan was started with a vision to educate children from the slums despite their formal schooling going on simultaneously. Kalakhadak and Shanti nagar were the two slums in PCMC, Pune where the project was started
- Project Gyan is not just a kind of tuition for children where they can come and study. It's way more than that. It's a hope for children who like to dream big and achieve them by working hard. It's a place where they can express themselves freely and learn as much as they want. It's a ray of light to a brighter future.

Impact

- 70 children benefited through the support classes.
- 200+ families were impacted through street plays, health check-ups and parent meetings

Snapshot : SNEH Pre School - RAINBOW

- SNEH Pre-school located at Kalewadi, Pune aims at providing quality education to the children of parents with limited means.
- School works on a Sponsorship model where every kid's education is partially sponsored by a well-wisher. 200+ sponsors have come together till date to support the initiative.
- Our change makers have ensured that 100% of the kids are enrolled to primary education either through RTE or otherwise. In addition, kids that are successfully admitted to primary schools are further supported and followed up through RTE support classes on weekends.
- Our vision to have a chain of SNEH preschool, especially for girls, in all the disadvantaged sections of the country so that Education, Nutrition and health are taken care of under one roof.

Education

Impact

- 93 students from the disadvantaged sector of the society were enrolled and given the quality English medium education from Nursery to Sr. KG through activity based approach.
- 90+ Families were impacted through health check-ups, parent trainings, awareness sessions etc.
- 25 students (out of 30) were successfully facilitated in the admission process of RTE to get into the private English medium schools in 1st Std.

From home maker to school – A happy turnaround

Aishwarya (7 years), Laxmi (10 years), Menaka (11 years), Suvarna (10 years), Priyanka (11 years), couldn't continue their schooling because they had to take care of a younger sibling at home and soon playing on streets all day turned into a habit.

SNEH Foundation convinced the parents along with the kids and got them enrolled into the government school. We believe not a single child should be deprived of education as that's the only thing which will sustain and help them live a healthy and happy life ahead by encroaching their poverty and illiteracy.



Adarsh & Rukmini lived up a dream they never thought of

SNEH Pre-School was started 4 years back with a vision to provide early childhood education to the children from marginalized families and create a strong foundation for the Primary and Secondary education.

Using Right to Education (RTE 25%) policy of the Indian government as a tool we enrolled our students from SNEH preschools to top ICSE, CBSE schools from PCMC. Adarsh was one of the 22 kids that were enrolled in reputed schools through RTE. Adarsh and his mother Rukmini are more than delighted for Adarsh will now be studying in Podar International School, Chinchwad Pune. In her words, "Sir, we have very small dreams, leave apart education I never thought of entering Podar international school in my life and now my son will study in one of the best schools in the city". These stories help us realize that SNEH is progressing towards it's mission and vision.

Health

Impact

Snapshot – Vatsalya

- INR.3 lakhs have been effectively spent on addressing health issues which included cases of Lung Tuberculosis, Appendicitis, ENT Operations, Cerebral Palsy, Neutral Disorders etc.
- 100 + Medical check-ups are done by our health care group with 1000+ direct beneficiaries in the community.
- 150 + health awareness sessions conducted by experts covering a wide range of maternal & child health issues.

- Health check-ups of around 392 beneficiaries were done by SNEH's panel of doctors along with awareness on basic health and hygiene
- Approximately 70 health cases were dealt with. In addition, 5 out of 9 severe health were successfully treated under SNEH foundation's project Vatsalya
- 6 HB camps in various communities of PCMC were conducted that covered 966 females and adolescent girls. This was coupled with counselling regarding Anaemia.
- 96 females/adolescent girls from the community were given treatment for Anemia

Bhimrao, a poor farmer from Akkalkot migrated to Pune because of drought and debt. With 3 daughters and a pregnant wife, life was 'bad to the bone' in one of the marginalized slum of pune 'Kalakhadak'.

SNEH Foundation understood the plight of the family and started working to help them in every possible way.



bringing the change that is sustainable

Jyoti, the youngest daughter who was severely malnourished and stunted is now part of the global growth hormone research project and is being treated by topmost doctors in India.

Vijaylakshmi, the eldest daughter who quit her studies to support her mother is now enrolled back to class 8th in Secondary school Wakad.

Saraswati, is one of our brightest in our daily classes at Kalakhadak and continues to surprise us with her hard work and ability to learn.

After the mother gave birth to the 4th kid, a son, we counseled her to get the sterilization done.

Bhimrao is now motivated and working hard to raise the standard of the family. As an organization we believe in bringing the change that is sustainable.

Visit to Domino's pizza

Children from the support class were taken to Domino's outlet where they learned to make pizzas and also got an opportunity to taste the same.



Support class

Project Gyan is run in the form of support classes for children from the slum of Kalakhadak in Wakad, Pune. It's a class that comprises students from all grades who are going to local schools. The students are imparted education on basic concepts of English, Maths and Science along with overall development.



Visit to Science park

As project Gyan focuses on holistic child development, SNEH also tries to give the children exposure to a lot of practical based learning. Visit to science park was one of such initiatives.
